

## Parent Pay

As we're sure you can appreciate safety is our biggest priority and as a result the Vale is attempting to create schools with as little money on site as possible. As a result with effect from the 31st July we will be using a secure website called ParentPay (see link on our website) to collect payments for trips and school meals.

We will also use this system to send out trip letters, newsletters and urgent SMS messages, (although you will also receive messages via Schoop, twitter and the website). You will be able to view your current balance for school meals and top up when convenient. An alert can be set up to warn you when your credit balance is running low.

We are asking all parents to register with ParentPay as soon as possible. Your child should have brought home a letter containing your login details. If you did not receive yours please contact the office. Some parents may already have an account with another school (Stanwell Comprehensive). Details of how to add a child to this account will be explained in your personalised introduction letter.

In an attempt to remove all cash and cheques from school we ask parents to use the secure website or pay in cash at local stores (PayPoints).
