

Guidance Sheet for helping pupils learn high frequency words

The words sent home are the words your child is learning at school. These are differentiated and pertinent to your individual child. You can help your child learn words in many ways. Firstly cut them up into individual words! Try to make the learning as fun as possible. You can:

- Copy the words onto card in 2 sets and play pairs
- Matching games or snap
- Look for the words in books at home during shared reading time
- Look for the words in the environment e.g. when shopping, on road signs
- Place the words around the house and go on a word hunt
- Put a collection of words into sentences for the children to read.
- Celebrate the learning of sets of words - reward, use a star chart etc.

We consider reading a very important skill that all children need to acquire. Please help with their learning. Please see the class teacher if you have any concerns.
